What is Home Window Tinting?

Window tinting is a thin film or sometimes laminate that is applied to the interior of your home's windows. There are several types of tinting that come in different colors, thicknesses, and grades.

The tinting, or window film, reduces visible light, infrared, and ultraviolet radiation. It is normally dyed or has been metalized. This changes the solar radiation that is coming into your home into infrared radiation. This infrared radiation is then sent back through the window to the outside. There are now also ceramic window films available that do not use dyes and are non-metallic.

There are several advantages of home window tinting, especially during the winter months. There is nothing worse than hearing your heater come on and stay on for long periods of the day and night, but window tinting can help.

Tinting will reduce the length of time that your furnace runs. This means that your home will heat up in less time and once it does, it will stay warmer for a longer period of time. This is in part because the tinting makes it easier for your windows to reflect light and heat. To put it simply, less heat can make its way through your windows to the outside after it has been reflected off the inside of your home. This keeps the head inside instead of leaking

through your windows.

This leads to the second advantage, saving money. It can seem that every month of the winter your heating utility bill seems to grow, but it doesn't have to be that way. **Because window tinting helps keep your home warmer for longer periods of time, you can save money every month while still being warm and comfortable.** In turn, your heating unit will work better and last longer while providing you better energy efficiency.

Another advantage of window tinting is a reduction in fading. If you have a piece of furniture that is in direct sunlight for a good part of the day, and you lift up the cushion or remove an arm covering it can be surprising just how badly the fabric has faded. This is caused by UV radiation coming through your windows. *Window tinting can reduce this radiation by 98 percent.* This means your furniture and other possessions are protected from the sun's harmful rays and will keep their beauty and last much longer than without window tinting. This protection from the sun's rays also means that *you and your family are also protected from UV radiation, which can cause skin cancer.*
