Not only does this spoil the external views, but it's also potentially damaging to your eyes and can make TVs, computer screens and pictures very difficult to see. *Modern window films, however, will block 99% of UV rays and eliminate glare without reducing light quality*.

Lower Energy Cost – Depending on the type of tint, they can also block up to 78% of the sun's heat. Typically this means a reduction of around 30% in the energy used by the cooling system.
